**ALEC in the law (LTECV of August 17th, 2015) :**  
**Article 192 (territorial animation), article 22 (PTRE), article 179 (data)**

General panorama of the network		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>12 covered metropolitan regions</b></li> <li>• <b>17 million inhabitants covered</b> (about 500 000 on average by ALEC)</li> <li>• <b>17 % cover more than a million inhabitants</b></li> <li>• <b>2/3 of the agencies are more than 10 years old of experiences</b> (1/3 created in the last decade)</li> <li>• ALEC intervenes in <b>all the scales</b> : municipal (54 %), agglomeration communities / EPCI / country (79 %), metropolises (25 %) and even departmental (38 %)</li> <li>• The <b>budget</b> of ALEC is in <b>constant increase</b> for 5 years</li> <li>• <b>Accumulated total budget = 25M € in 2017 → 1,47€ by inhabitant/year on average</b></li> <li>• <b>The local and national subsidies constitute 70 % of the budget of ALEC and 67 % of the contributions</b> are abounded by <b>communities</b></li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• About <b>50 % of the presidents of agency have mayor's mandate</b></li> <li>• <b>65 % of ALEC in urban area / 35 % in rural area</b></li> <li>• <b>4 territories accompanied</b> in 2018 by <b>FLAME</b> within the framework of a <b>ALEC project</b></li> </ul>
